The Event

On Thursday, October 11th, Zombies will be taking over CityWalk as AMC Theaters hosts the World Premiere of the independent Horror/Comedy "Zombies! Zombies! Zombies!". Everyone is invited to join the cast and crew for this event which includes an after-party at CityWalk's "The Groove" Night Club. The screening is scheduled for 7pm, and it is recommended that tickets be purchased in advance online at www.ZombiesZombiesZombies.com

The Movie

A drug experiment gone wrong produces a league of blood-thirsty zombies. It is up to a small band of exotic dancers trapped in a gentlemen club to fight back. Together they must rely on their wits and skills to survive the night, and pray that they don't become victims of the flesh-eating zombies!

This tongue-in-cheek Horror/Comedy revolves around a group of Strippers who have to go to battle against a league of brain thirsty Zombies.

The film is not yet rated, but viewer discretion is advised due to Language, Brief Nudity, and Lots of Zombie Killing.

The film stars a cast of talented Central-Florida actors and includes Hollie Winnard (Beauty & the Geek 2, Playboy), Jessica Barton (FHM, Playboy), and Hollywood Scream Queen Tiffany Shepis (The Hazing, Corpses, Nightmare Man).

The Process

Two years ago, a collaboration began between long time friends, Tony Giordano (Screenwriter/Producer), and Jason Matthew Murphy (Director/Producer) to make a horror movie. After a year of script development, the decision to move forward was made. Financed entirely on their own through loans and credit cards, the duo set out to make something truly fun for horror movie fans. "It's more of a Horror/Comedy than a serious horror film" says Jason. "I'm not really a huge fan of horror movies, so when Jason and I spoke about making one, I wanted to make sure that it was something that I would enjoy watching myself." says Tony. "It turned out to be a really fun process."

As Tony wrote, Jason worked on finding the perfect crew to help them with the production. He was eventually put in contact with the very talented Kenny Beaumont (Director of Photography). Since he was an instructor at Full Sail, Kenny brought a willing and capable crew with him. "I remember the first day of shooting, it was so surreal. All these guys pulled up in a huge truck and started pulling out tons of equipment for our little horror movie." recalls Tony. "Jason looked at me and said 'We're making a movie'".

To get the blood and gore effects needed, Jason recruited the well-known make up artist Rick Gonzalez. Rick's work can be seen in several horror films, including George Romero's Day of the Dead and upcoming Orlando film Automaton Transfusion.

With the help of the Department of Transportation, Jason and Tony were extremely fortunate to acquire the former Club Jauna to use as their location. "Since the story takes place in a strip club, it was the perfect location to shoot at. All the décor was still in there, including the chairs and even the cash registers. We used every inch of the place for the shooting locations, and it even doubled for other sets like the police station. The only bad thing was we only had one working toilet and there were a LOT of people." says Tony.

Jason Matthew Murphy, a local photographer and director, graduated from the Valencia Film Program in 1996, and has been working in the Film & Video field ever since. "After years of working on other peoples projects, it was finally time to call in some favors and make my own project." says Jason.

Tony Giordano, a performer and part time Associate Show Director at Disney, has been doing video production for several years as a hobby. This hobby has finally evolved into more professional stage. He has written and produced several shows for the Orlando Fringe Festival and also wrote and directed the well received short film "Harker".
